

Conditions for the 3 & 4 Day Learn to Dive Courses.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Prior to commencing your dive course you are required to complete the selfassessment Student Diver Medical Declaration. A positive response to any questions indicates there is a pre-existing condition which may affect your safety while diving and you must consult a medical practitioner, preferably with experience in diving medicine, to obtain a dive medical certificate that states you are medically fit to dive. View the Student Diver Medical Declaration form.



Medical must be completed within 90 days of starting your dive course.

3 DAY LEARN TO DIVE COURSE WITH eLEARNING

If you're ready to take the plunge to become a certified diver but are short on time, this 3 day course is ideal. Classroom theory is replaced with PADI's online eLearning which can be completed in your own time, after which you're ready to join us at our Dive Centre to complete your Open Water training.

Step 1: Complete PADI eLearning component

PADI eLearning must be completed before you can begin your practical training.

Conditions: Some medical conditions such as asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, heart and lung disease will prevent you from diving. If you are unsure, please contact us for more information. Minimum age to learn to scuba dive is 10 years. We recommend that you not fly for 24 hours after diving. Your final scheduled Open Water dive will be completed by 2:30pm.

EMC: A Government Environmental Management Charge per person per day is levied for all adults and children 4 years and over entering the Great Barrier Reef World Heritage Area. This charge is included in the total price.

Surcharge: Due to potential significant volatility in supply and operational costs, a surcharge may be applied due to unforeseen circumstances. In such cases, any charge will be collected on departure. Prices are per person, in Australian dollars and valid until 31 March 2025.
